

Graduate Certificate in Global Management

The Graduate Certificate in Global Management is a program for students who aim to pursue a career that includes international business interests and global management competencies. Students will develop knowledge and skills relevant to developing and evaluating global and international management strategies and approaches to managing diversity, communicating across cultural contexts, evaluating international business objectives, making multinational managerial finance decisions, and comparing sustainable business practices, innovation, and the design of work in different economies.

The Graduate Certificate in Global Management will be awarded upon successful completion of the 9-credit curriculum below. The courses are not listed in sequential order.
